
- Enhancing outreach efforts, particularly towards international students





SASKATOON ENGINEERING COMPETITION(SEC)

What is SEC?

The Saskatoon Engineering Competition (SEC) is an annual event organized by the University of Saskatchewan to select participants for the Western Engineering Competition (WEC). It provides engineering students the chance to develop and demonstrate technical, communication, and problem-solving skills.

- Categories: SEC consists of 8 distinct competition categories: Communications, Consulting, Impromptu Debate, Innovative Design, Junior Design, Programming, Re-Engineering, Senior Design.
- Preparation and Timing
 - Depending on the category, teams either prepare their presentations ahead of time (Communications, Innovative Design) or receive topics with limited preparation time (Impromptu Debate).
 - For other categories, teams have 6 hours on the day of the competition to learn about their topic and create their presentations or prototypes.

SEC serves as a stepping stone for University of Saskatchewan students aiming to compete in WEC.

 - Additional presentations


Previous Success: Last year's event was held at Louis and attracted over 90 attendees, showcasing its popularity among students.
