## External Affairs

- APEGS meeting
  - Cut student engagement activities fund

    - NOT the pool that discipline societies pull from
  - Task force for the engagement fund
    - Looking for two members to be on the committee
    - Brief discussion about getting more people aware of APEGS
- Q: Do we know who APEGS is funding and therefore who to ask for money?
  - A: We don't. Apply for funding through the SES
- Q: Deadline for APEGS funding?

A: Sometime in October. No concrete date. (probs lying about October, Should be finalized end of December)

- WESST Exec meeting happened this summer
  - Experience with how other societies operate
- UBC Vancouver left WESST last year
  - o Still included in plans because they left too late in the year to change anything
    - Will not be allowed to attend meetings without joining WESST
- Q: Why did they leave?
- A: The current exec felt they did not get enough out of WESST. They will be reviewing their decision at the end of this year.
- CFES PM hosted by SFU Burnaby
  - Budgeted for only Noah going
    - Bobby went anyways
    - Ended up saving a lot of money
      - Also gave Noah a bunch of stress
    - Laid groundwork to become a founding member of the Coalition of International Engineering Student Organizations (CIESO)
    - SESS was the first organization to sign on (#First)
    - Other members of the group include
      - Board of European Students of Technology (BEST)
      - Germany equivalent (BONDING)
      - America's equivalent (NAESC)
      - First IEC held in 2020
    - CEC (2019) hosted by Waterloo "A"
  - Will have a report on PM before heading to his next meeting
- WESST AGMR (Annual General Meeting Retreat) is his next meeting
  - o In two weeks
  - Same camp (but with UVIC)
  - No Agenda yet
  - Elections for the WESST exec will happen
    - Short application period due to the lack of money to send people
    - Bobby, Logan, and Shanleigh will be going
      - Paying themselves to go
