Over Thanksgiving weekend, the Western Engineering Student Societies' Team (WESST) hosted their Annual General Meeting and Retreat (AGMR) at Camp Jubilee, located near Deep Cove, BC.



WESST is an alliance of engineering student societies across western Canada and consists of 12 member societies from 11 engineering programs. WESST helps its member societies share expertise on organizing events, managing budgets and services for undergraduate engineering students.

AGMR is a four-day conference that serves as a time for new engineering students to make connections within WESST, where there are sessions on topics related to student involvement & professional development. The conference includes a day of plenary sessions in which student societies vote on policy that best represents their schools interests. AGMR also serves as a time for Members to elect the new WESST Executive Team for the 2018/19 academic year. The election results are as follows:


