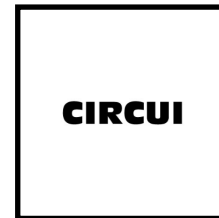
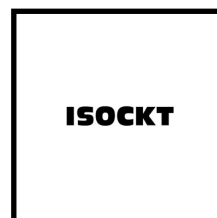
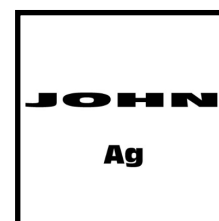
Dear Picasso,

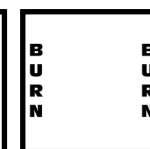
