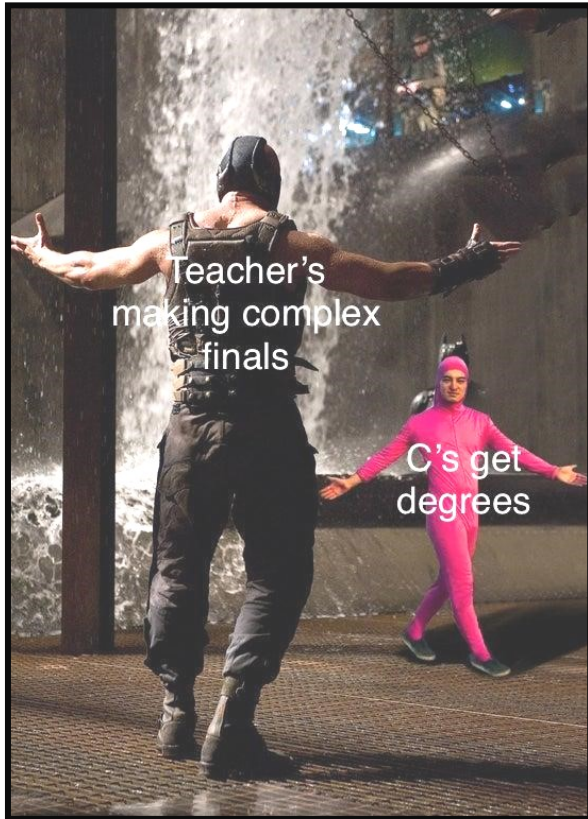
U of S Sled Dogs Quarter Scale Tractor Team

The team is made up of students from across campus, but we are always looking

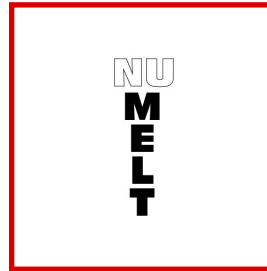
