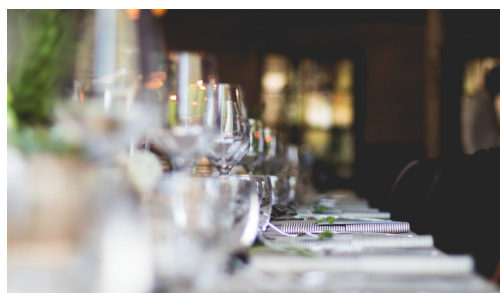

1976: Spectrum Exposition

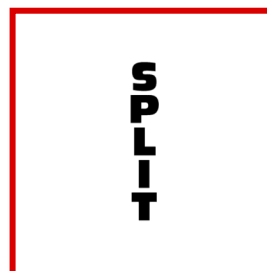
