VOTE! Don't just complain!

Here's how you can get started today:

Do your research. Check out the site in this code to see brief overviews of each party's standings on important issues, side by side. Pulled from their platform websites and social media. Factual, simple, efficient.



Campus voting stations will be set up in Place Riel from October 5th to October 9th, 10am— 10pm. Vote while waiting for the bus!

Voting at a polling station only takes 3 minutes.

- Takes less time than getting Tim Hortons at Geo.

Bring ID. You have a few options for this:

- Driver's License or other government ID with your photo, name, and *current* address.
- Two pieces of ID both must have your name, at least one with your *current* address (ex. your student card and a utility bill).
- Your Student ID card is valid as a second piece of ID, but not as a proof of residence.
- If you struggle to find a proof of residence, you can register online through Elections Canada to get a voter information card with your current address.
